

Twelve Step Within Committee Report

- The Committee started the activities with a great enthusiasm. The fellows splitted in 3 different sub committees:
 - The Traditions Study Workshops Subcommittee
 - The Steps Study Workshops Subcommittee
 - The Resources for Newcomers and Members in Relapse Subcommittee
- The main committee decided to proceed with The Traditions Study Workshops first and then with The Steps Study Workshops, while The Resources for Newcomers and Members in Relapse subcommittee could work independently.
- The Traditions Study Workshops has been organized in 90-minute meetings starting the 9th January 2021 – for 14 weeks (until 10th April 2021) welcoming only 20 fellows so we could give the impression to be sit in a room with 4 or 5 volunteers for service. We prepared a flyer sent with an announcement, GDPR consent, there were volunteers replying to emails and a spreadsheet where to insert the availability to give service and which kind of service. Books in English for speaking English as second language fellows have been purchased and mailed to members of the subcommittee in order to lead the workshop. The workshop was successful and at the end of it the majority of fellows participating in those sessions keeps getting in touch with the purpose of share ESH in matter of Traditions, Concepts and Service, Policies and Procedures. The Traditions Study Workshops Subcommittee wanted to organize another round but there was lack of volunteers. There's a waiting list to attend this set of Workshops.
- The Steps Study Workshops couldn't be set up for lack of volunteers to give service even if we had everything prepared: the day (Saturday at 8,30 UK Time), the length (19 sessions lasting 90 minutes), departure date (26th of June), one time 7th tradition (20 GBP/EURO), GDPR consent and other details
- The list of resources for newcomers and members in relapse is completed and now ready to be upload on the R9 website.
- The TSW Committee had the project to translate the Traditions Study Workshops as approved during 2019 R9 Assembly in Ciampino (Italy) but there were some copyright issues. WSO suggested to send to the WSBC to be approved and now the original text of the Traditions Study Workshops has now gone to the World Service Business Conference Literature Committee and it has been approved for consideration.
- I replied to email messages from OA R9 Fellows asking for help and advice and attended regular meetings with R9 BOARD.
